



## INSTALLATION DE CUPS-PDF POUR MAC

### Introduction

[CUPS-PDF](#) is a backend module for [CUPS](#) (Mac OS X's printing system) by Volker C. Behr that, rather than printing to a device, prints straight to PDF files.

Why use this rather than a simple "Save as PDF" in the print dialog?

- Pressing return is faster.
- Batch-print through the writer to convert documents to PDF.
- Common save location for all generated PDFs.

### Installation (Snow Leopard)

- Install the package.
- Open System Preferences and go to Printing.
- Click on Add Printer (the + at the bottom).
- "CUPS-PDF" should be in the list, select it.
- Select "Postscript" from the "Print Using" menu and pick "Generic postscript color printer"
- Click Add

### Use

Print to the printer normally. The output will be in `/Users/Shared/CUPS-PDF` in a folder with your user account's name. Feel free to make an alias to this folder on your desktop or put it in the Dock.
